Even younger adults with hearing loss are at risk.

People with hearing loss fall up to 2.5 times more often than people with normal hearing.

Researchers suspect that people with hearing loss have increased falls because:



They may be less aware of their surroundings



May have difficulty with spatial awareness



They use more effort to listen
